



Miranda Police have charged a man after a number of incidents on the North Cronulla beachfront vesterday.

A 20-year-old man was arrested shortly before 5pm after a press photographer allegedly had his equipment damaged while taking photos near the surf club.

Police and ambulance officers were in the area following an earlier incident in which two men were involved in an altercation nearby. One man suffered minor injuries in this incident.

The Riverwood man was taken to Miranda Police Station and questioned before being charged with malicious damage in relation to the photography incident.

He was allowed conditional bail and is due to appear in Sutherland Local Court on January 12.
