12/12/2005 10:57pm Report of males on railway lines

Cronulla

From an off duty officer, six (6) or more Middle Eastern males walking along the railway lines heading towards Cronulla Railway Station. Currently about 500 metres away from Station. 597

12/12/2005 10:58pm Report of brawl outside Novotel

Brighton

Community source advised 100 persons fighting outside the Novotel in Bay Street, Brighton-le-Sands. Persons bashing occupants of vehicles stopped at traffic lights. Police attended 11:05pm - No fights at Novotel, 598

12/12/2005 10:59pm Convoy at The Grand Parade and Bay Street

Brighton

Anonymous male advised convoy of 15 vehicles with ethnic males heading north on The Grand Parade yelling abuse 599

12/12/2005 10:59pm Convoy gathering on Rocky Point Road

Sans Souci

Community source advised 50 vehicles blocking traffic awaiting other vehicles to catch up. Vehicles heading north along Rocky Point Road, Sans Souci (x Fontainebleau Street). Occupants are carrying bats and sticks. 600

12/12/2005 11:00pm Report of assault north of Railway Station

Cronulla

Eight (8) males assault another male on Gymea Bay Road, Gymea (x Kingsway). 601

12/12/2005 11:00pm BP Service Station at Sans Souci

Sans Souci

Community source advised of a silver Holden Commodore in the BP Service Station. San Souci (x Russell Ave). There was a large group of Middle Eastern people standing on the road and yelling. 602

12/12/2005 11:00pm Report of gathering in Bay Street

Brighton

Numerous Middle Eastern persons congregating on Bay Street and heading towards the beach. 603

12/12/2005 11:00pm Attempt to run down police officer

Cronulla

Police were patrolling the vicinity of Kurnell Road and The Kingsway when information was received concerning 30 Middle Eastern males in Kurnell Road. As police turned into Kurnell road a blue Ford Laser containing Middle Eastern male was observed. Police stopped to speak with the occupants of this vehicle. Police identified themselves and asked the driver what he was doing in Kurnell Road. The driver shrugged his shoulders and said, "What." Police exited the police vehicle to speak further with the occupants. The driver of this vehicle has then revved the accelerated towards the police officer. The police officer took evasive action and the vehicle speed off east along The Kingsway. Police reported the incident via the Police radio and the vehicle was stopped a short time later in Elouera Road by other police. The driver was arrested and taken back to Miranda Police Station and charged. 604

12/12/2005 11:11pm Report of preparation of fire bombs

Cronulla

Community source had received a call from a friend who had been chased into a house by a group of Lebanese. The friend advised they [Lebanese] were outside making some fire bombs to retaliate. The group was in Thomas Street, Woolwooware (x Howie Ave). 612

12/12/2005 11:14pm Gathering at Punchbowl Park

Punchbowl

Males of Middle Eastern appearance commence congregating in Punchbowl Park. At 11.36pm report of 100 males in park. At 11.43pm report of 300 - 400 males now in park. 23:44pm report of men carrying baseball bats, bars, poles and machetes and damaging parked vehicles. CIDS reports from community sources on numbers and activities of gathering in the park not entirely consistent with reports from an unmarked police vehicle parked nearby monitoring the situation at Punchbowl Park over entire period in question. Plainclothes police supplied regular updates by mobile phone to the Campsie Forward Command Post. A marked police car patrolling the area at 11.29pm estimated approximately 100 persons in the park at 11.30pm. No offences were observed by the plainclothes police officers at the scene. These officers reported that the persons congregating were 'just standing around talking with each other'. Police helicopter was also requested to monitor activity in park. All persons in park eventually dispersed without incident in different directions. 613

12/12/2005 11:14pm Crowd reforming at Kings and Queens Roads

Brighton

Troublemakers from Cronulla area are congregating at the intersection of Kings and Queens Roads. They are reforming and returning to the area. 614

12/12/2005 11:15pm Superintendent Rogerson completed duty

Maroubra

Superintendent Rogerson leaves Maroubra. Risk to area significantly lowered. 615

12/12/2005 11:20pm Rampaging crowd in Bay Street

Cronulla

Police responded to a crowd brawling and causing trouble in the vicinity of Grand Parade and Bay Street. Police were confronted by a crowd of 100 Middle Eastern people who were rampaging west in Bay Street. The crowd was pulling council bins from their mounts and throwing them and other objects at shop windows. The crowd also threw objects at police vehicle and as a result two police vehicles were damaged. The crowd dispersed up several streets. A large number of police, including the Dog Squad and OSG, attended the area. The area was patrolled but no offenders were arrested and no injuries reported. 616



11:27pm Vehicles damaged in Bruce Street

Brighton

- About 10 persons sighted damaging vehicles in Bruce Street, Brighton (x Sellwood Street). 617
- About 30 people using baseball bats, fence palings, rocks and fire extinguishers to damage vehicles and apartments. 618
- Group of 6 persons smashing cars and phone boxes near the Shell Service Station. 619
- Large group of youth making noise and there is a gas bottle in the middle of the street. 620
- (23:34) Middle Eastern male being chased by Police is in garage underneath unit wearing army pants and brown shirt. Police came with dog but were on the other side of the fence. The Male is still in the garage. 621

### 12/12/2005 11.30pm Cronulla

Sometime in the afternoon Monday 12/12/2005 went to pick up two friends in Chester Hill enroute to the Mosque as many people were meeting there. When they reached the Mosque they realised they were late and that everyone had left. They drove to the Kingsway and met up with a large convoy of vehicles that were driving along slowly with their hazard lights on. They stopped on The Kingsway to pick up two strangers as their vehicle had broken down. Whilst on The Kingsway in the Cronulla area they stopped the vehicle and two of the exited the vehicle and damaged parked vehicles with metal poles. The two occupants stopped a white utility travelling along The Kingsway and smashed that vehicle with metal poles. Both occupants returned to the vehicle and the convoy continued to Elouera Road.

When they reach Elouera road the convoy stopped. The occupants from vehicle exited and began smashing parked vehicles with the hundreds of other people. The group returned to the vehicle and drove to the BP Service Station at Taren Point. Their vehicle was refuelled and they then headed towards Brighton. They parked their vehicle for a while at Brighton.

About 11:25pm and his occupants were driving along the Princess Highway. They observed a silver Mitsubishi Lancer and pulled along side of this vehicle. Youssef and El-Sheick then exited the vehicle and attacked the Mitsubishi Lancer and its occupants with the metal rods. 622

# 12/12/2005 11:30pm Male assault leaving Novotel

Cronulla

Male was assaulted whilst leaving his work at the Novotel Brighton. He was stopped and assault by a group of Middle Eastern Males. 623

12/12/2005 11:30pm Male attacked in vehicle

Sans Souci

The victim was driving his silver Mitsubishi Lancer along the Princess Highway. Near the intersection of Park Road the victim stopped at traffic lights. Another vehicle, being driven by stopped beside him containing Middle Eastern males The driver asked questions of the victim's nationality and whether they were at Cronulla. A passenger in the second vehicle held up a baton. The male passenger has exited the vehicle with the baton and walked to the driver's door and yelled for the victim to get out of the car. This person started bashing the driver's window and rear window. The victim drove off and reported the incident to police. 624

12/12/2005 11:30pm Female attacked in vehicle

Cronulla

The victim was driving east on the Kingsway towards Cronulla and stopped at the intersection of Gannons road for a red traffic light. A vehicle containing Middle Eastern males stopped beside he and said, "you dirty bitch." The males then started throwing a barrage of rubbish at her, including an object that struck the victim in the head. The victim drove off and reported the matter to police. No details of the offending vehicle were obtained. 625

# 12/12/2005 11:30pm Gathering at 7/11 Convenience Store

Cronulla

- 11:30pm A motorcycle assaulted earlier in the evening attended the 7/11 store. Upon arriving he observed 10 Middle Eastern males standing in the car park holding baseball bats. The victim then contacted '000'. 626
- 11:35pm Five (5) to 10 males chased one lady. Lady ran inside 7/11 store. Males are waiting outside. Lady is scared to leave. 627
- Caucasian male chased by Middle Eastern males armed with baseball bats and would not let 11:41pm him into the garage. 628
- 11:43pm 15-20 Middle Eastern males gathering outside location and threatening passerby's. 629

12/12/2005 11:30pm Assault in Restwell Street, Bankstown

Bankstown

The 50 year old female victim was walking from Bankstown Railway Station along Restwell street after completing work. The victim was approached by a Middle Eastern male and he took her handbag and hit her in the head with a solid object. This caused a laceration to the back of the victims head. The offender has then run off south along Restwell Street. The victim was conveyed to Bankstown Hospital with minor injuries. No offender has been identified. 630

# 13/12/2005 12:01am Fire at Auburn RSL Tennis Club

Auburn

Security advised alarms had been triggered at the club at 12:00am. The Fire Brigade received a call for the club on fire at 12:13am. They attended 12:19am and observed the side door to the club was alight. The Fire Brigade extinguished the blaze by 12:45am. A subsequent investigation showed a five (5) litre petrol tin was empty on the ground against the wall leading down the side of the club. 636

Bankstown

A convoy of vehicles heading south through Bankstown gathered in Gordon Street, Bankstown. A vehicle was stopped and searched. During the search one occupant from this vehicle stated they were heading to Cronulla. 639

13/12/2005 12:25am Campsie Command Post closed

Lakemba

Command Post officially closed by Superintendent Richardson after consultation with Superintendent Benson (POC MIRT Commander). 640

13/12/2005 12:52am Staff abused at Bankstown RSL

Bankstown

Five (5) Middle Eastern persons in three (3) vehicles are yelling abuse at staff and are threatening to assault them. The victim, a serving Military Officer, was with several friends at the Bankstown RSL. Whilst leaving he was approached by the group of Middle Eastern youths and was taunted, with the group saying, "Come on out you Aussie dogs." The victim remained near the entrance of the club. The vehicles had driven past his location and parked about 50 metres away from the club's entrance. The victim contacted police as he believed a trap had been set for himself and other Caucasian people leaving the premise. Police attended but did not locate any vehicles, 641

1:00am Assault at McDonald's

Bankstown

10-12 Middle Eastern Males assaulted another male at McDonald's, Hume Hwy Liverpool (x Atkinson Street). About that time the victim was walking home from a friends place when he was approached by a Middle Eastern male who said, "Are you an Aussie" The victim said, "Yes" and continued on his way. The victim was then attacked by a group of Middle Eastern males, the group kicked and punched the victim numerous times before running off towards the Liverpool RFA. The victim sustained bruising and was conveyed to Liverpool Hospital for treatment. The victim stated he did not know any of the offenders. 642

13/12/2005 1:00am Report of male being chased with weapons

Cronulla

The Community source was being chased by a group of males with weapons. The source was running along Perryman Place, Cronulla (x Kingsway) at the time. Police arrived at 1:05am and spoke with three (3) people, no offences detected. 643

13/12/2005 1:10am Resources deployed to bridges

Cronulla

Further police resources deployed to Alford's Point Bridge and Captain Cook Bridge. 644

13/12/2005 3:00am Sexual assault by Middle Eastern males

Maroubra

About 2:30am the victim caught a taxi from the Coogee Bay Hotel to the intersection of Lenthall and Todman Avenues Kensington. They began to walk home. About 3am the victim was about 100 metres away from her home when four (4) Middle Eastern males approached her from a nearby vehicle. One of the males approached her from behind and held a knife to her throat. The males pushed the victim into a brick wall, grabbed her hair and one male pushed his hand up under the victim's skirt. At this point two Caucasian males have approached and pull the victim away from the males. They told the victim to run away and don't look back. The victim ran to her unit and was not aware of what occurred between the males. 645 The incident was reported to police at 4:49pm and police attended the victim's unit at 5am where an investigation was conducted. Extensive police inquires and DNA testing failed to identify offender. 646


Four (4) people taken into custody for Affray to be released from Sutherland due to identification issues. 647

10:30am Female chased by Middle Eastern males

Kirrawee

Informant was at intersection of Waratah Road and Princess Highway, Kirrawee. A vehicle containing Middle Eastern males stopped beside her and said,"Get off the phone, we're gonna come and get you Aussie slut and we're gonna rape you." The informant drove home and reported the matter. No person of interest has been identified. 649

13/12/2005

1:00pm Assault by Middle Eastern males

Hurstville

About 1pm the victim was at Hungry Jacks on Forest Road, Hurstville. At the time a group of Middle Eastern Males were outside Hungry Jacks looking inside. The victim walked around Westfield for a short time and was then confronted by the group of six (6) Middle Eastern males. This group then kicked and assaulted the victim. During the assault one Middle Eastern male said, "You shouldn't fuck with us Lebo's. Fuck off out of Hurstville you stupid Aussie, you're nothing but a dog, do you want some too?" As a result of the assault the victim received a cut requiring stitches and general grazing and bruising. The victim was conveyed to St George hospital for treatment. A person of interest was identified at the time of the incident. 650 However in subsequent inquiries, victim declined to participate in an identification parade. 651

13/12/2005 1:36pm Report of Islanders enroute to Cronulla

Sutherland

Large group of Islanders arriving on trail from Sutherland. Gang known as "Crips" & were spoken to the previous day in Cronulla as they were looking for trouble. OSG in attendance. Area patrolled no person sighted. 652

13/12/2005 2:06pm Report of Islanders causing trouble

Hurstville

15-20 Islander males at bus stop on Forest Road hassling passerby. 653
